## WORKS INFORMATION AND NOTIFICATION LETTER:

High Street, Old Amersham

We are writing to inform you that Buckinghamshire Highways will be carrying out Priority Road surfacing works along The High Street, Old Amersham from the road narrowing's/ speed control to Town Hall.

The works are programmed to take place from Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> May, and it is anticipated the carriageway surfacing work will take approximately 4 nights to complete. The work will be carried out using a road closure, in operation Tuesday to Friday between 20:00 and 06.00.

Information signs have been erected on site prior to the commencement of the works, giving actual dates and durations. Please appreciate that works of this nature are extremely weather dependant and therefore may be subject to disruption due to adverse weather. If the works are delayed, the advance information signs on site will be updated to reflect any changes.

Every effort will be made to maintain access for residents, although there may be times when it is not safe to do so, and we apologise for any inconvenience. It is vital that vehicles are not parked on the road and/or footway as this will prevent the works from being completed.

## Alternative parking arrangements

Residents may park in the Amersham Old Town Car Park - Amersham HP7 OUT for the duration of the works. Please email us at least three days in advance of the works at <a href="mailto:parking.services@buckinghamshire.gov.uk">parking.services@buckinghamshire.gov.uk</a> with your name, address, contact details, registration number, car model/colour to ask for a dispensation to use these car parks during our works.

We apologise for the short notification for these carriageway repair works. These are being undertaken as emergency works due to the rapid deterioration of the road and the repair has been accelerated by Buckinghamshire Council. Again, we are sorry for any inconvenience caused.
