## WORKS INFORMATION AND NOTIFICATION LETTER:

High Street, Old Amersham

We are writing to inform you that Buckinghamshire Highways will be carrying out Drainage works along High Street, Old Amersham from Church Street to Mill Lane.

The works are programmed to take place from Monday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2023, and it is anticipated the Drainage works will take approximately 6 weeks to complete. The work will be carried out between 09:30 and 15:30 using multi-way traffic lights which will be in place 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Information signs will be erected on site prior to the commencement of the works, giving actual dates and durations. You will appreciate that works of this nature are extremely weather dependant and therefore may be subject to disruption due to adverse weather. If the works are delayed, the advance information signs on site will be updated to reflect any changes.

Every effort will be made to maintain access for residents, although there may be times when it is not safe to do so, and we apologise for any inconvenience.
